PAPER FLIGHT CERTIFICATES EXPIRE ON MARCH 31, 2010

Paper pilot certificates must be replaced by the newer plastic versions by March 31, 2010. If you have a **plastic** pilot certificate, issued after July 2003, you do not need to order a replacement. Follow the link below to get the page on the FAA Website which explains the ruling and provides instructions for replacing your certificate. Also, as of March last year, anyone wanting to fly internationally must have the words "ENGLISH PROFICIENT" printed on their certificate under "Limitations." All new certificates include this, so if yours does not, just order a replacement certificate from the FAA.
